Learn about the raptors (birds of prey) in BC, and especially in the Okanagan! Find out how they fly, and make your own raptor glider to take home. Whose will fly the fastest and furthest? Dissect an owl pellet or make an owl mask!

August 15-18, 2011

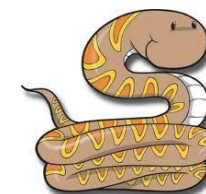
Distinguish between black bears and grizzly bears. Learn about bear safety, and how to be 'bear aware'. Play a fun outdoor bear game and make an art project to take home.
